ORDER

The parties have informed the Court that the above action has been settled, but that additional time is needed to consummate the settlement. Defense Counsel is further **DIRECTED** to file a status report **within 60 days** from the date of this Order, advising the Court whether the Settlement Agreement has been fully executed and submitted to CMS for payment. The Clerk of Court is **DIRECTED** to enter judgment dismissing this action with prejudice and without costs **120 days from the date of this order**. The parties are advised that the 120-day period to consummate settlement will not be extended absent exceptional circumstances. In light of the parties' settlement, the Court **DENIES AS MOOT** all pending motions and **VACATES** all deadlines and hearings.
