MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Before the Court is Magistrate Judge Gilbert C. Sison's Report and Recommendation ("R&R"). (Dkt. No. 44). Magistrate Judge Sison recommends that this Court dismiss Defendants John/Jane Doe and Richard Watson pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).

The Court may accept, reject, or modify—in whole or in part—the findings or recommendations of a magistrate judge in a R&R. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3). The Court must review de novo the portions of the R&R to which objections are made. <u>Id.</u> The parties have 14 days after service of the R&R to file written objections. SDIL-LR 73.1(b). "If no objection or only partial objection is made, the district court judge reviews those unobjected portions for clear error." Johnson v. Zema Sys. <u>Corp.</u>, 170 F.3d 734, 739 (7th Cir. 1999).

The Court received no objection to the R&R, reviewed the entire file, and finds that the R&R is not clearly erroneous. Accordingly, the Court hereby:

- **ADOPTS** the R&R in its entirety (Dkt. No. 44);
- **DISMISSES** Defendant John/Jane Doe; and

• **DISMISSES** Defendant Richard Watson.
