MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on the Notice of Dismissal (Doc.14) pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(i) filed by plaintiff USA. Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(i) allows a plaintiff to dismiss an action without a court order at any time before the opposing party serves an answer or a motion for summary judgment.
