

place of business is in Quebec City, Canada, it contains no allegation of the country of incorporation of the defendant. Wilson v. Humphreys (Caymen) Ltd., 916 F.2d 1239, 1242 n.2 (7th Cir. 1990).

Although the case may be subject to dismissal on these grounds, Thomas v. Guardsmark, LLC, 487 F.3d at 534, the court instead affords the plaintiffs twenty days from the date of this order within which to file an amended complaint alleging the existence of diversity jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1332.
