OPINION AND ORDER

Gregory Konrath, a pro se prisoner, filed a civil lawsuit on a habeas corpus form.¹

However, Konrath is restricted from filing in any civil case in this court “until he has paid in full all outstanding fees and sanctions in all civil actions in any federal court . . .” *Konrath v. Unity Healthcare, LLC*, 3:17CV9 (N.D. Ind. filed January 4, 2017). That restriction has not been lifted and Konrath may not circumvent it by merely using a habeas corpus form.

For these reasons, this case is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** and the clerk is **DIRECTED** to note this filing as a violation of the restriction order.
