**ENTRY ON TELEPHONIC SCHEDULING CONFERENCE**


On May 13, 2008, the parties appeared, by counsel, for an informal, telephonic scheduling conference. It was discussed and agreed that the parties will address the merits of this action by summary judgment motion pursuant to the following schedule:

- ! On or before May 19, 2008, Plaintiffs shall provide Defendants with advance, courtesy copies of the affidavits that Plaintiffs expect to utilize in support of their summary judgment motion.
- ! On or before May 23, 2008, Plaintiffs shall file their summary judgment motion.
- ! Defendants' response shall be filed on or before June 6, 2008.
- ! Plaintiffs' reply shall be filed on or before June 12, 2008.
- ! Requests for oral argument should be made in accordance with Ind. S.D. Local Rule 7.5.

The Court will make every effort to rule on the anticipated summary judgment motion before the July 1, 2008, effective date of the statute at issue. If that becomes impossible, the Court will address the request for injunctive relief.
