- 5. This motion is not made for the purpose of delay and Defendant will not be prejudiced by the Court granting Plaintiff leave to file her amended complaint in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests the Court to grant her leave to file her amended complaint and demand for jury trial in this matter and for all other relief the Court deems just and proper in the premises.
