ORDER

The Federal Judicial Center, the educational arm of the United States Courts, in 2002 produced and published an approximately 17 minute long video designed to be shown to jurors in patent jury trials. It contains background information intended to help jurors understand what patents are, why they are needed, how inventors get them, the role of the PTO, and why disputes over patents arise. It was developed with the assistance of an advisory committee of district judges and patent attorneys and the FJC represents that special care was taken to be even handed.
