ORDER

This case comes before the court on the motion of the plaintiff, Justin R. Belisle, to compel the defendant, BNSF Railway Company, to produce documents responsive to two discovery requests (doc. 44). Defendant has filed a response (doc. 46), and plaintiff has replied (doc. 47).
