MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Plaintiff, Terry L. Lanier, has alleged false arrest and excessive force arising from his actual arrest on April 8, 2012. He filed his lawsuit in federal court on May 12, 2013.

Defendants have moved to dismiss on the grounds that the applicable statute of limitations, KRS 413.140(1)(a) bars these claims. Of course, Defendants are quite correct here that the statute does bar the claims. Plaintiff has made no real argument to the contrary.
