- 7. On February 19, 2009, the Court denied Plaintiff's Request for Oral Argument on Plaintiff's Motion for Reconsideration.
- 8. The parties wish to continue the hearings on the above-referenced motions and postpone the preparation and filing of memoranda in opposition to those pending motions.
- 9. The parties have conferred concerning a new hearing date (without oral argument in the case of the Motion for Reconsideration) for the motion to dismiss, and the parties hereby request that this Court reset all pending hearings and oral argument for Wednesday, April 1, 2009, at 10:00 a.m.
- 10. All parties, including counsel for the Plaintiff, Vicki L. Pinero, and counsel for Crescent City Tax Service, Inc., have agreed to and join in this request.
- 11. This is the first requested continuance of the hearings on the above-referenced pending motions.
- 12. A short continuance of the hearings on the above-referenced pending motions should not unduly delay trial or the prompt resolution of this matter.

For these reasons, Jackson Hewitt prays that its Consent Motion to Continue and Reschedule the Hearings on Motions be granted, and that the hearings on these pending motions be rescheduled to Wednesday, April 1, 2009, at 10:00 a.m.
