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**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS' EX PARTE CONSENT MOTION FOR
LEAVE TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD AND SUBSTITUTE ORIGINAL DECLARATION**

NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned counsel, come Plaintiffs, Hornbeck Offshore Services, L.L.C. ("Hornbeck"), the Bollinger Entities and the Chouest Entities (collectively, "Plaintiffs"), which respectfully submit this memorandum in support of their Ex Parte Consent Motion for Leave to Supplement the Record and Substitute Original Declaration seeking to leave to supplement the Court's record and substitute the original declaration of Ford Brett, which is

attached to Plaintiffs' Motion, for the copy filed as an attachment to Plaintiffs' Ex-Parte Motion for Leave to File Declaration of Ford Brett That Was Inadvertently Not Filed with Rec. Doc. 29 (Rec. Doc. 51).

Plaintiffs initially intended to file a copy of the declaration of Ford Brett as an exhibit attached to Plaintiffs' Motion to File Affidavits and Declaration (Rec. Doc. 29), which was filed June 16, 2010. However, after discovering that the declaration of Ford Brett was inadvertently omitted from the exhibits attached to Plaintiffs' Motion to File Affidavits and Declaration, Plaintiffs moved the Court for leave to file into the record a copy of the declaration of Ford Brett. See Plaintiffs' Ex-Parte Motion for Leave to File Declaration of Ford Brett That Was Inadvertently Not Filed with Rec. Doc. 29 (Rec. Doc. 51), filed June 19, 2010. The Court granted Plaintiffs' motion to file a copy of the declaration of Ford Brett. See Order (Rec. Doc. 64), filed June 21, 2010. The Court later granted Plaintiffs' motion to file original affidavits and declaration for the purpose of supplementing the Court's record. See Order (Rec. Doc. 89), filed June 24, 2010.

In Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to Supplement the Record and Substitute Original Declaration, filed herewith, Plaintiffs request leave of the Court to file into the record to leave to supplement the Court's record and substitute the original declaration of Ford Brett, which is attached to Plaintiffs' motion filed herewith, for the copy previously filed as an attachment to Plaintiffs' Ex-Parte Motion for Leave to File Declaration of Ford Brett That Was Inadvertently Not Filed with Rec. Doc. 29.

Plaintiffs respectfully submit that Plaintiffs' Ex Parte Consent Motion for Leave to Supplement the Record and Substitute Original Declaration should be granted. Undersigned counsel has requested and obtained Defendants' consent to Plaintiffs' Motion.
