Subject: Change of the Name of the Minerals Management Service to the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation, and Enforcement

Sec. 1 Purpose. The purpose of this Order is to change the name of the Minerals Management Service (MMS) to the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation, and Enforcement (BOEMRE).

Sec. 2 Authority. This Order is issued under the authority of Section 2 of Reorganization Plan No. 3 of 1950 (64 Stat. 1262), as amended.

Sec. 3 The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation, and Enforcement

- a. The Minerals Management Service shall hereafter be named the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation, and Enforcement.
- b. The BOEMRE shall be headed by a director and shall be under the supervision of the Assistant Secretary—Land and Minerals Management.
- c. The BOEMRE shall exercise all authorities previously vested in the MMS.

Sec. 4 Implementation. The Assistant Secretary—Land and Minerals Management and the Assistant Secretary—Policy, Management and Budget shall take all appropriate steps to implement this Order including, but not limited to:

- a. Changing all references of the MMS to BOEMRE in the Departmental Manual;
- b. Promulgating a brief rule in the Federal Register changing all references of the MMS to BOEMRE in the Department's regulations; and
- c. Notifying the Congress of the name change from the MMS to the BOEMRE.
