
ORDER AND REASONS

Before the Court is a **Motion for New Trial, Reconsideration, and/or Relief from Judgment (Rec. Doc. 37)** filed by complainants-in-limitation Down South Marine (DSM) and Leblanc Marine. Claimants David Williams (Williams) and Terrence Hankton (Hankton) oppose the motion. Hankton's memorandum in opposition (**Rec. Doc. 42**) readopts and reavers the entirety of Williams' memorandum (**Rec. Doc. 41**). The motion, set for hearing on **November 23, 2011**, is before the Court on the briefs without oral argument.¹ The Court finds that movants have not presented any new issues or facts meriting a new trial, reconsideration, or relief from judgment.

Accordingly;

IT IS ORDERED that the **Motion for New Trial, Reconsideration, and/or Relief from Judgment (Rec. Doc.)** filed by complainants-in-limitation Down South Marine (DSM) and Leblanc Marine, is hereby DENIED.
