ORDER AND REASONS

Before the Court is plaintiff Ward Roosevelt's motion to stay.¹ On March 30, 2012, the Louisiana Supreme Court granted a writ application in *Duckworth v. Louisiana Farm Bureau Mutual Ins. Co.*, No. 2011-C-2385, and *Quinn, et al. v. Louisiana Citizens Property Ins. Corp.*, No. 2012-C-0152. These cases address the issue of whether filing class action lawsuits suspends the running of prescription against insureds who file individual lawsuits before a class certification determination is made. Because this prescription issue could be dispositive in this matter, the Court GRANTS plaintiff's motion.
