ORDER AND REASONS

Following the Court's issuance of its November 14, 2014 Order and Reasons (Rec. Doc. 38), Plaintiff submitted an opposition (Rec. Doc. 40) to Defendant State Farm Fire and Casualty Company's October 8, 2014 motion for summary judgment (Rec. Doc. 25).
