Defendant Mentor Worldwide, LLC moves the Court to dismiss plaintiff's claims against Mentor under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6). Defendant argues that plaintiff's claims are preempted by federal law under *Riegel v. Medtronic*, 552 U.S. 312 (2008), because the claims challenge the safety or effectiveness of a medical device that received premarket approval from the FDA. Plaintiff does not oppose dismissal of her claims against Mentor. Mentor.

Defendant is correct that plaintiff's claims against it are preempted under *Riegel*. Accordingly, the Court GRANTS the motion and dismisses plaintiff's claims against Mentor with prejudice.
