Addison and A. Harris, Orleans Parish Police Sergeant R. Fayard, and Orleans Parish Detectives Brian Elsensohn, Scott Seymour, and Raymond Hughes, is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** as frivolous and for failure to state a claim for which relief can be granted pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1915(e), 1915A, and 42 U.S.C. § 1997e.
