IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the verdict of the jury be and is hereby made the judgment of the Court and, accordingly, that there be judgment in favor of plaintiff, Marine Power Holding, L.L.C., and against defendant, Malibu Boats, LLC, in the amount of ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$1,800,000.00), plus prejudgment interest from the date of judicial demand in the amount of ONE THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED HUNDRED **TWO** DOLLARS AND 58/100 (\$138,302.58), for a total award of ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED **TWO** DOLLARS AND 58/100 (\$1,938,302.58), together with interest thereon at the rate

provided by law from the date of the original judgment until satisfied, plus costs recoverable by plaintiff under Rule 54(d)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
