ORDER AND REASONS

Pro se litigant Julius Alexander filed this 42 U.S.C. § 1983 civil rights action, complaining about the conditions of his confinement and that correctional officers strip searched him and other inmates.¹ The Magistrate Judge recommends that Alexander's complaint be dismissed with prejudice.² Alexander did not file objections to the Magistrate Judge's findings. Having reviewed *de novo* the complaint, the record, the applicable law, and the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation (R&R), the Court approves the R&R and adopts it as its opinion.
