ORDER AND REASONS

Before the Court is the plaintiff's motion for summary judgment. On December 14, 2016, the Court granted in part the plaintiff's motion insofar as the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services had not conducted an adequate search for the requested record, a Form I-797C Receipt Notice, and the Court took under submission issues pertinent to the plaintiff's remaining claim that USCIS had not produced the responsive record.
