**ORDER**

Before the court is plaintiff's **Rule 72 Objection to and Request for District Court Reconsideration and Reversal of the Magistrate's March 30, 2021 Order** (Rec. Doc. 138). At plaintiff's request, due to his involvement in an automobile accident and his COVID-19 diagnosis, the motion was continued and set for submission on August 11, 2021. The Objection took issue with the portion of the Magistrate Judge's order imposing a 14-day deadline from its entry to respond to outstanding discovery requests.
