## **ORDER AND REASONS**

The Court has reviewed *de novo* plaintiff's complaint and amended complaint,<sup>1</sup> the applicable law, the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation,<sup>2</sup> and plaintiff's objection.<sup>3</sup> The Magistrate Judge correctly determined that plaintiff's allegations against defendant for employment discrimination are frivolous.<sup>4</sup> The Court finds that plaintiff's objection that he "would like to send this case to the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals" is meritless.<sup>5</sup> Accordingly, the Court adopts the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation as its opinion.
