

ORDER AND REASONS

The Court, having considered Plaintiff Donquiel William Griffin's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 Complaint,¹ the record, the applicable law, the Report and Recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge,² and the failure of the Plaintiff to file any objection to the Report and Recommendation,³ hereby approves and adopts the Report and Recommendation as its opinion in this matter. In doing so, the Court notes that it has construed Plaintiff Donquiel William Griffin's *pro se* pleading liberally.⁴

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 claims against St. Charles Parish are **DISMISSED without prejudice** pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b) for his failure to prosecute.
