RULING

In this appeal, plaintiff seeks review of the Magistrate judge's ruling of April 13, 2009, ordering the plaintiff to pay the Court's filing fee within 20 days of the date of the order, April 13, 2009.

Because of the number of frivolous cases the plaintiff has filed, which are set forth in footnote 1 of the Magistrate Judge's order, the Clerk of Court shall not accept any further suits from the plaintiff unless plaintiff pays the \$350.00
