Before the Court is Petitioner's PETITION UNDER 28 USC § 2254

FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS BY A PERSON IN STATE

CUSTODY (Doc. 1). The Magistrate Judge has issued a REPORT (Doc.

15) recommending that Petitioner's application for habeas corpus relief be denied as untimely pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2244(d), and, further, that the Court deny Petitioner a certificate of appealability, (id. at p. 18). Petitioner does not object to the Magistrate Judge's Report.
