RULING AND ORDER

On February 7, 2014, United States Magistrate Judge Richard L. Bourgeois, Jr. issued a Report and Recommendation, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B), recommending that the final decision of the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration (the "Commissioner") be affirmed, and Plaintiff Dwayne Anthony Scott's ("Scott") appeal be dismissed, with prejudice. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Dwayne Anthony Scott's appeal is

DISMISSED, with prejudice.
