RULING AND ORDER

Before the Court is Petitioner's PETITION UNDER 28 U.S.C. § 2254 FOR

WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS BY A PERSON IN STATE CUSTODY (Doc. 1).

The State of Louisiana has responded to Petitioner's application by arguing that

Magistrate Judge for further proceedings." (Id. at p. 11). The State has filed an

objection to the Magistrate Judge's recommendation. (Doc. 16).

Having carefully considered Petitioner's PETITION (Doc. 1) and related

filings, the Court APPROVES the Magistrate Judge's REPORT (Doc. 15), and

ADOPTS it as the Court's opinion. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that this matter

be referred back to the Magistrate Judge for further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the District Attorney for the Eighteenth

Judicial District Court for the Parish of West Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana: (1)

supplement the record in this matter to address, if possible, the deficiencies noted in the Magistrate Judge's Report; and (2) file a supplemental memorandum addressing the merits of Petitioner's Petition, and any remaining issues in this case.
