The Court, after carefully considering the *Petition*, the record, the law applicable to this action, and the *Report and Recommendation* of United States Magistrate Judge Richard L. Bourgeois, Jr. dated November 22, 2013, to which no objection has been filed, hereby approves the *Report and Recommendation* of the Magistrate Judge and adopts it as the Court's opinion herein. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendants' *Motion to Dismiss*<sup>2</sup> is granted, dismissing Plaintiff's claims asserted against Defendants, with prejudice, for failure to
