**RULING**

The Court, after carefully considering the *Complaint*<sup>1</sup>, the record, the law applicable to this action, and the *Report and Recommendation*<sup>2</sup> of United States Magistrate Judge Stephen C. Riedlinger dated February 5, 2015, to which no objection has been filed, hereby approves the *Report and Recommendation* of the Magistrate Judge and adopts it as the Court's opinion herein.

**ACCORDINGLY**, the Defendants' *Motion for Summary Judgment*<sup>3</sup> is hereby granted, and the Plaintiff's *Complaint* is dismissed for failure to state a claim, predicated on the Plaintiff's failure to exhaust available administrative remedies pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1997e(a), and with prejudice to refiling the complaint *in forma pauperis*. Further, the claims against the remaining, unserved Defendants, are dismissed pursuant to Rule 4(m).
