RULING AND ORDER

On August 13, 2014, the United States Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1), recommending that Plaintiff Forest Hardy's Complaint (Doc. 1) be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> (Doc. 12).
