<u>ORDER</u>

The court *sua sponte* notes the potential insufficiency of the removing defendant's allegation of the citizenship of the parties as follows;

1.		A party invoking diversity jurisdiction must allege the <i>citizenship</i> rather than mere residence of an individual. In addition, see <u>28 U.S.C. §1332(c)(2)</u> for infants, minors and an incompetent. The <i>citizenship</i> of is not provided.
2.	X	A party invoking diversity jurisdiction must allege both the state of incorporation and principal place of business of each corporate party. See, e.g., <u>Illinois Central Gulf Railroad Co. v. Pargas, Inc.</u> , 706 F.2d 633 (5 th Cir. 1983). The state of incorporation and principal place of business of State Farm automobile Insurance Company, Progressive Casualty Insurance Company, Nationwide Casualty Insurance Company and USAgencies is not provided. ¹
3.		A party invoking diversity jurisdiction must allege both the state of incorporation and principal place of business of each corporate party. <i>See, e.g., Illinois Central Gulf Railroad Co. v. Pargas, Inc.</i> , 706 F.2d 633 (5 th Cir. 1983). Even when a liability insurer takes on its insured's citizenship under 28 U.S.C. § 1332(c)(1), its own citizenship still is considered in determining whether complete diversity exists. The state of incorporation and principal place of business of is not provided. ²
4.	<u>X</u>	A party invoking diversity jurisdiction must properly allege the citizenship of a limited liability company. The citizenship of a limited liability company for diversity purposes is determined by the citizenship of its members . The

¹The phrase "principal place of business" in §1332(c)(1) refers to the place where a corporation's high level officers direct, control, and coordinate the corporation's activities, *i.e.*, its "nerve center," which will typically be found at its corporate headquarters. <u>Hertz Corp. v. Friend</u>, 130 S.Ct. 1181, 175 L.Ed.2d 1029 (2010)

5.		A party invoking diversity jurisdiction must properly allege the citizenship of a general partnership, a limited liability partnership, and a limited partnership. A general partnership, a limited liability partnership, and a limited partnership has the citizenship of each one of its partners. Both the general partner and limited partner must be alleged to establish citizenship of a limited partnership. See International Paper Co. v. Denkmann Assoc. , 116 F.3d 134, 137 (5th Cir. 1997); Carden v. Arkoma Associates , 494 U.S. 185 (1990). The citizenship of is not provided.	
6.		A party invoking diversity jurisdiction must properly allege the Underwriters at Lloyd's, London. The citizenship of Underwriters London has not been provided. <i>See Corfield v. Dallas Glen H.</i> 853 (5 th Cir. 2003).	ters at Lloyd's,
7.		A party invoking diversity jurisdiction must properly allege the sole proprietorship. A business entity cannot be both a corpora proprietorship; therefore the court seeks to clarify the identity of plaintiff/defendant. Case law suggests that the citizenship of a for diversity purposes is determined by the citizenship of its mowners. See <u>Linder Enterprises v. Martinringle</u> , No. 07-1733, (N.D.
