**RULING**

The Court, after carefully considering the *Complaint*,<sup>1</sup> the record, the law applicable to this action, and the *Report and Recommendation*<sup>2</sup> of United States Magistrate Judge Richard L. Bourgeois dated September 5, 2017, to which no objection has been filed, hereby approves the *Report and Recommendation* of the Magistrate Judge and adopts it as the Court's opinion herein.

**ACCORDINGLY**, Ultra Lane, Ltd.'s *Unopposed Rule 21 Motion to Drop Non-Diverse Party and Leave to Amend*<sup>3</sup> is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART. Ultra Lane, Ltd.'s *First Amended Complaint* shall be filed into the record of these proceedings.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that DRC Emergency Services, LLC be DISMISSED without prejudice from this action, and Ultra Lane, Ltd. is ORDERED, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1653, to file a *Second Amended Complaint* providing the citizenship of Hartford Fire Insurance Company within seven (7) days of entry of the *First Amended Complaint* into the record.
