complaint, within 30 days of the date of this Opinion, limited to the single remaining claim, naming as

Defendants only those persons alleged to have some form of involvement in the claim, and stating what

actions or inactions on the part of each named Defendant caused the alleged violation(s).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff's Amended Complaint and Second Amended

Complaint (Docs. 2 and 4) are stricken.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff's pending Motion to Amend (Doc. 21),

seeking to add additional unrelated and unexhausted claims, is denied, and that this matter is referred back

to the Magistrate Judge for further proceedings herein.
