J U D G M E N T

Before the court is a report and recommendation issued by the magistrate judge, in which it is recommended that plaintiff's civil rights complaint be denied and dismissed with prejudice.¹ Plaintiff timely filed objections to the report and recommendation.² The court has reviewed the magistrate judge's proposed findings, as well as the objections filed by plaintiff and finds that the report and recommendation issued by the magistrate judge is correct under applicable law and jurisprudence. In so finding, the court specifically notes that plaintiff's objection based on the magistrate judge's jurisdiction is made in error.
