J U D G M E N T

For the reasons stated in the Report and Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge previously filed herein, noting the absence of objections thereto, and concurring with the Magistrate Judge's findings under the applicable law;

IT IS ORDERED that Evans's §2241 petition is DENIED AND DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
