


(E.D. La. 1993). For the reasons stated in open court during the July 6, 2012 hearing on Cantu Services' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, the court finds that Cantu Services has not demonstrated that denial of its Motion to Stay will cause it to suffer irreparable harm. *See also Howard v. Town of Jonesville*, 935 F.Supp. 855, 859 (W.D. La. 1996) (holding that the plaintiff in a civil rights action could not demonstrate irreparable injury even if she could demonstrate a likelihood of success on the merits of her § 1983equal protection claim). Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the motion is DENIED.
