




these Plaintiffs. The Magistrate Judge further ordered the clerk to mail notice of the order to these Plaintiffs to the addresses provided in the pleadings.<sup>3</sup>

As of this date, these Plaintiffs have not responded to the discovery requests, nor have any of the Plaintiffs opposed the instant motion to dismiss. Accordingly,

**IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the motion to dismiss is hereby **GRANTED** dismissing with prejudice all claims of Plaintiffs Heather Armstrong, Tristan Armstrong, Julie R. Blaylock and Cody Cahanin.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Clerk of Court close the instant lawsuit.
