**ORDER**

On July 9, 2013, the court instructed removing defendant to file 1) an amended notice of removal to establish diversity of citizenship, and 2) a memorandum, together with supporting documentation and/or affidavits, if appropriate, sufficient to establish that the requisite jurisdictional amount was in controversy at the time of removal. (July 9, 2013, Order [doc. # 10]). On July 12, 2013, defendant so complied. *See* Amend. Notice of Removal and Memo. [doc. #s 11 & 12].<sup>1</sup>

Upon review of defendant's submissions, in combination with the original notice of removal,<sup>2</sup> the court finds that removing defendant has met its burden to establish diversity jurisdiction. 28 U.S.C. § 1332.
