
JUDGMENT

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Plaintiff Greg Stevens' claims against the Sixth Judicial District, District Attorney's Office, the State of Louisiana, and Attorney Joy Jackson are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** as frivolous and for failing to state claims on which relief may be granted.
