**Dear Mr. Musgrove:**

In order to satisfy your inquiry regarding a DHL package received from Mr. Bentley in 2007 and its return to the same, regarding my Affidavit of March 5, 2008, and regarding other correspondence to opposing counsel Gary McGoffin, I offer the following.

I acknowledge receipt from Mr. Bentley of a DHL shipment in 2007 containing disclosure from the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals (LaDHH) directed to Mr. Bentley. Mr. Bentley's representation to me was that said disclosure was provided to Mr. Bentley by the LaDHH in the time frame of their deposition in the matter of 'Bentley v. Fanguy'. Mr. Bentley indicated the LaDHH provided four identical sets of said disclosures; one for the Court reporter, one for Mr. Bentley, one for Mr. McGoffin, and one with no designation. Mr. Bentley stated that Mr. McGoffin did not take his set; said set being the one shipped to me. I returned these materials to Mr. Bentley in December of 2007 sometime before Christmas. As you know, per your direction I have removed from my computer ALL Bentley data, save emails.

I did send [email] an Affidavit to Mr. McGoffin on March 5, 2007. However, Mr. McGoffin was only one of several recipients, which included Mr. Bentley's counsel Ed Bankston and the Court of record in this matter. The Affidavit described my repeated attempts via email and telephone conversations with either Mr. Bentley or his counsel [Ed Bankston] to cease and desist the use of my name, likeness, or testimony to perpetuate misrepresentations or omissions I learned of between November 27 to November 31, 2007. The Affidavit describes these attempts were met with threats from Mr. Bentley. The Affidavit describes, upon advice of counsel, that I

then promptly notified each party to the litigation orally and by emails that I DID NOT want my name, likeness, or testimony used to perpetuate any misrepresentations or omissions. The Affidavit reads that only Mr. McGoffin responded, with whom I had correspondence on several occasions, stating my reluctance to be re-deposed, and then my acquiescence if it was, "the only way to set the record straight", or otherwise to prevent the use of my name, likeness, or testimony to perpetuate misrepresentations or omissions. These correspondences, I believe, entail Mr. Bentley's concerns over, "other correspondence to opposing counsel".

The Affidavit also reads that nothing I might have testified to in the cancelled deposition included any information known to me or learned of while LCM Corporation served Mr. Bentley. As stated hereinabove, the information regarding said misrepresentations or omissions was learned of by me in the course of personal conversations with Mr. Bentley from November 27 to November 31, 2007.

The Affidavit also requested of the parties to the Bentley litigation and the Court of record that I be alleviated of having to give testimony in deposition to prevent further harassment.
