## ORDER

As previously explained to Plaintiff during the telephone pretrial conference held on December 17, 2014 [See Doc. #190], corporations and LLCs cannot appear in federal court without representation of counsel. See Rowland v. California Men's Colony, 506 U.S. 194, 202 (1993); Memon v. Allied Domeca OSR, 385 F.3d 871,873 (5th Cir. 2004) (per curiam) (citing Rowland and Southwest Express Co., Inc.)(corporations, partnerships and associations may not appear in federal court unless represented by an attorney); U.S. v. Hagerman, 545 F.3d 579, 581–82 (7th Cir. 2008) (rationale applies to limited liability companies as well); Lattanzio v. COMTA, 481 F.3d 137 (2d Cir. 2007)(same). Accordingly, noting the absence of enrolled counsel, the Court hereby finds that A & H Oil Interest, LLC has abandoned its position in this litigation.

The clerk is asked to terminate A & H Oil Interest, LLC in the record of the abovecaptioned matter.
