
IT IS ORDERED that Lavergne's civil rights complaint be **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** subject to reassertion if the requirement of *Heck v. Humphrey* are met.

Alternatively, **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Lavergne's claims against District Attorney Mike Harson be **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1915(e)(2)(B)(ii) for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.

Alternatively, **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Lavergne's claims against the Fifteenth Judicial District Attorney's Office be **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1915(e)(2)(B)(ii) for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Lavergne's claims under Louisiana State law be **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
