MEMORANDUM RULING AND ORDER

Pending before the Court is the "Consent Judgment" [Doc. 20] submitted by counsel for plaintiffs and defendants in the above-captioned matter. The Consent Judgement is DENIED as presented, as it contains inherent questions of law and/or fact and ambiguities that could impact certain remaining aspects of the pending matter, which could impede the effective operation of justice. The parties are in no way prohibited from selecting another procedural vehicle, and/or clarifying the open-ended questions presented in this proposed document, or removing the ambiguities presented as to fact and law. Nonetheless, this Court will not sign the document as written.

Considering the foregoing, the Consent Judgment [Doc. 20] is DENIED.
