ORDER ON MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

In its September 15, 2010 Order on Motion for Temporary Restraining Order (Docket # 31), the Court explicitly reserved ruling on the Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Docket # 4). The Court indicated a willingness to hold the previously scheduled oral argument on that motion if either side wished to have a hearing. Therefore, for reasons fully explicated in the September 15, 2010 Order, the Court hereby DENIES Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Docket # 4).
