## ORDER AFFIRMING RECOMMENDED DECISION OF THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE

On January 4, 2013, the United States Magistrate Judge filed with the court, with copies to counsel, her Recommended Decision on the defendant's motion for summary judgment. The defendant filed an objection to the Recommended Decision on January 22, 2013.
