## ORDER AFFIRMING THE RECOMMENDED DECISION OF THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE

- 4. It is further ORDERED that Defendants Jailers at Penobscot County Jail, Deputy Mason, and Penobscot County Sheriff Department's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings (ECF No. 22) be and hereby is GRANTED.
