The United States Magistrate Judge filed his Recommended Decision (ECF No. 21) with the court on June 25, 2017, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(b). The Plaintiff filed an Objection to the Recommended Decision (ECF No. 26) on August 7, 2017. The Defendant then filed a Response to the Plaintiff's Objection (ECF No. 27) on August 21, 2017.
