On May 4, 2018, the United States Magistrate Judge filed with the court, with copy to the parties, his Recommended Decision on the Plaintiff's Motion for Order of Medical Services (ECF No. 89), Plaintiff's First Motion Requesting Judicial Review (ECF No. 101), and Plaintiff's Second Motion Requesting Judicial Review (ECF No. 110).
