ORDER ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDED DECISION
OF THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE

United States Magistrate Judge John H. Rich III filed his Recommended Decision (ECF No. 24) on Susan S.’s Social Security Disability and Supplemental Security Income appeal with the Court on July 30, 2018 pursuant to 28 U.S.C.A. § 636(b)(1)(B) (2018) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b). The time within which to file objections expired on August 13, 2018 and no objections have been filed.
